
Our current regulations provide one vote for each Residential member in good standing, and up to three votes for each Commercial and Institutional member in good standing. The regulations provide that Commercial and Institutional members may designate up to two representatives, each entitled to one vote. If you are a Commercial or Institutional member and you have not designated two people to be your representative, and you desire to do so, you must notify our office by either emailing Cynthia Cejka at Cynthiac@oldbrooklyn.com, or faxing us at 216-459-1741, no later than the close of business on Monday, October 11, 2009. If you do not notify our office by October 11, 2009 of your representatives, then those representatives will not be able to vote at the annual meeting.


