Dear Mayor Jackson:

The residents of Old Brooklyn are still in direct opposition to the Letter of Intent the City of Cleveland presented at the Bradley Road Landfill Public Meeting July 13, 2011.

The proposed surface/strip mine and C&D landfill will continue to poison our neighborhood with persistent organic pollutants. We have endured these air, water, and soil pollutants for the last 20 years. We do not want 15 more years of these persistent pollutants and the additional potential release of nuclear radiation pollutants from the Harshaw Chemical disposal area.

To underscore our opposition to the City's Letter of Intent concerning this surface mine and C&D landfill we are enclosing a letter packet we sent to various public officials who are signatories to the Great Lakes Compact. (Letter & contact list enclosed)

This surface strip mine and C&D landfill has the potential of releasing refined uranium and persistent bioaccumulative toxins into the Cuyahoga River and the Great Lakes. This is a clear violation of the Great Lakes Compact and the Great Lakes Ecosystem Protection Act of 2010.
